About VegOttawa Fest

VegOttawa Fest is our cornerstone event that brings VegOttawa's mission to life—promoting a vibrant vegan lifestyle, supporting local plant-based businesses, and strengthening community connections in Ottawa.

Building on a strong legacy of annual VegFests held between 2011 and 2017, VegOttawa **revived the festival in 2025** recognizing the growing interest in plant-based living driven by health, environmental, and ethical considerations. The one-day event, held at the Ottawa Conference and Event Centre, welcomed approximately 2,500 attendees and featured over 50 exhibitors, alongside a full-day educational speaker program and live cooking demonstrations.

VegOttawa Fest provides an inclusive platform where the public can discover vegan options, learn from experts, and engage directly with local businesses and organizations—advancing VegOttawa's vision of an informed, connected, and growing plant-based community in Ottawa. Our partners and sponsors help to make this volunteer-run event possible.



VegOttawa Fest 2026

In 2026, VegOttawa Fest will return to the Ottawa Conference and Event Centre for a **one-day event in late July**. As with our previous events, it is designed to bring together a diverse audience—from seasoned vegans to the veg-curious—for a fun, informative, and engaging experience, featuring food, products, talks and activities centred around the growing plant-based movement in Ottawa, Canada, and the world.

Key features of VegOttawa Fest 2026:

- **Free admission**, making the event appealing and accessible to a broad audience
- An expected turnout of **3,000+ attendees**
- A tradeshow with **70+ exhibitors**, from food and beverage businesses, to lifestyle and service-based organizations, non-profits and more
- A full-day of **speaker programming**, including cooking demonstrations
- **Entertainment** for all ages, including live music, balloon art and face painting
- Facilitated opportunities to **build community and connection**
